TAX ABATEMENTS

Residential Abatement Program

Tax abatements are available for residential property owners for additions to existing properties. Taxes on the first \$15,000 of the total assessed valuation of the improvement will be fully abated for five years after the project is completed.

Commercial Tax Abatements

Tax abatements are available for new commercial properties in the Egg Harbor City Industrial Park and for additions to existing businesses. Taxes on the full assessed valuation of the improvement will be abated in 20-percent increments for five years after the project is completed.
