Unaccepted items like plastic bags can shut down the machinery that's essential to sorting materials, and dangerous contaminants like needles can hurt workers on the front-line. In addition, the contamination has forced China, the word's largest importer of these materials, to impose strict laws that may threaten our recycling program for future generations. Help us resolve these issues by making sure you only place items in your blue bin that are accepted in our recycling program. WASTE GUIDELINES

Bulk Waste: Two bulk items per trash day are permitted including furniture and carpet cut into 4' lengths rolled and tied. No electronics, construction debris or items containing Freon.

Electronics: Electronics must never be disposed of in your curbside trash or recycling bins. You may drop off at the Highway Department Garage from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday. Please do not leave items when facility is closed.

Rigid Plastics: Large plastic items that cannot be recycled in your blue bin can be recycled at the Highway Department Garage from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday. Please do not leave items when facility is closed.

Yard Waste: Yard waste includes leaves, grass, brush, branches, clean wood, Christmas trees. No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales. NO plastic bags! Place in kraft bags or properly marked containers.

Plastic Bags: Plastic bags cannot be recycled in your curbside bins. Please recycle them at designated bins in stores or switch to reusable bags!
